Arunachal Pradesh



The remains of this place are generally ascribed to the Chutia rulers who ruled over the region of Sadia from the thirteenth to the sixteenth century AD. As per legends, *Chutias* of Sadia traced their ancestry to Raja Bhisimaka, the legendary king. It is claimed that Birpala, the founder of the kingdom, was a descendant of Raja Bhisimaka.

The ancient city wall contains decorative tiles - depicting figures of humans, animals, birds, flowers and geometrical patterns. There is a small shrine of *Tamresvari* - probably a family deity of the Chutia Chiefs.
